## Business Development Program (Agriculture)

Provides funding for skills training, business planning and implementation, benchmarking and risk management activities which will expand domestic and international markets for Prince Edward Island producers and small to medium sized agri-businesses.

The three funding categories are:

1. Training;
2. Business Planning; and
3. Benchmarking and Risk Management

### *Funding - Training*

#### **Agri-Skills Individualized Training**

- 50 % of assistance up to \$2,000 is available per participant per fiscal year for eligible agri-skills individualized training expenses;
- 50% of assistance up to \$1,000 is available for eligible software expenses per participant over the life of the CAP Framework Agreement (2018-2023)

#### **Group Training for Agricultural Producers, Agri-Processors and/or Agri-Businesses**

- 90% of assistance up to \$20,000 per project is available for agricultural producers, agri-processors, and/or agri-businesses' eligible expenses.

#### **Organizational Development**

- 50% of assistance up to \$10,000 per project is for eligible training for executives' expenses; and
- 50% of assistance up to \$15,000 per project is for eligible board capacity training expenses.

### *Funding – Business Planning*

- 50% of assistance up to \$5,000 per project is available for eligible financial assessment and financial action plan expenses over the life of the CAP Framework (2018-2023)
- 50% of assistance up to \$10,000 per project is available for eligible succession plan expenses over the life of the CAP Framework (2018-2023)
- 50% of assistance up to \$2,500 per project is available for eligible business plan expenses for beginning farmers who are part of the bonafide farm operation over the life of the CAP Framework (2018-2023)
- 50% of assistance up to \$10,000 over the life of the CAP Framework Agreement (2018-2023) is available for groups of two farming entities' eligible project expenses.
- 50% of assistance up to \$15,000 over the life of the CAP Framework Agreement (2018-2023) is available for groups of three or more farming entities' eligible project expenses.

#### *Funding – Benchmarking and Risk Management*

- 90% of assistance up to \$15,000 is available for first time benchmarking or risk management initiatives' eligible expenses; and
- 30% of assistance up to \$15,000 is available for **approved** repetitive benchmarking or risk management initiatives; eligible expenses.

## Future Farmer Program

To support the expansion of domestic and international competitiveness by supporting new farmers to improve the probability that they establish or continue profitable and sustainable commercial farm businesses. The program will help new entrants through three streams of entry, identify and prioritize their business goals and will help them identify planning, management and technical skills that are needed to reach their goals.

#### *Funding*

##### **Agri-Skills Individualized Training**

- 50% of assistance up to \$2,000 is available per participant per fiscal year for eligible agri-skills individualized training expenses;
- 50% of assistance up to \$1,000 is available for eligible software expenses per participant over the life of the CAP Framework Agreement (2018-2023)

##### **Group Training for Agricultural Producers, Agri-Processors and/or Agri-Businesses**

- 90% of assistance up to \$20,000 per project is available for eligible group training for agricultural producers, agri-processors, and/or agri-businesses' eligible expenses.

##### **Organizational Development**

- 50% of assistance up to \$10,000 per project is for eligible training for executives' expenses; and
- 50% of assistance up to \$15,000 per project is for eligible board capacity training expenses

## Ag Action Manitoba

### Training and Consulting

Ag Action Manitoba helps farmers access training and consulting to expand farm business management skills and supports decision-making through planning advice and financial analysis. This funding will help individual farmers improve their understanding of how to grow a profitable farming operation.

#### *Funding*

The Training and Consulting activity will be funded on a 50:50 cost share basis between government and applicant and has a total funding cap of \$5,500.

Funding caps are applied to the farm business unit, which includes all shareholders. Within each activity, there are identified focus areas available for funding.

## Business Advisory Services Program 2018-2019

To enhance Nova Scotia farms' and agri-businesses' ability to be more competitive, manage transition, develop risk management strategies and respond to change. The business advisory services offered under this program will enable the agriculture sector to be proactive in business development decisions.

### *Funding*

Each applicant may be eligible for 50% assistance to a maximum of \$10,000 in the Business Advisory Program. Over the life of the Canadian Agricultural Partnership, applicants are eligible to apply and claim for each type of plan one time only with the exception of feasibility and marketing studies for new projects or products. ## Small Farm Acceleration Program

The objective of the Small Farm Accelerator Program is to support the growth of Nova Scotia small farms through the implementation of business planning and farm growth strategies. The support of a loan interest rebate program will also allow for improved accessibility to working capital. The program will allow small farms to make significant strides in reaching or working towards commercial viability.

## Agricultural Skills and Knowledge (ASK) Program

Assists producers with educational expenses for farm management courses or training activities. This program is available to producers to gain the knowledge necessary to increase profitability and minimize risks on their farm.

### *Funding*

ASK is a rebate program that requires applicants to successfully complete the course or training activity before a claim is made.

Applicants can apply for a rebate of up to 50% of the total eligible costs to a maximum program payment of \$2,500 per person per year. Maximum funding available is \$10,000 per person.

The minimum program payment for ASK is \$250 per person.

## Farm Management Agriculture Partnership Program

Supports collaboration with industry in areas that address priority farm management issues, including farm transition, costs of production, workforce development and risk management.

Funding will be targeted to fill identified gaps within industry to build overall farm management capacity. ## Agriculture Business Program

This program will enhance market development opportunities and growth, address market access challenges, and increase knowledge transfer and skills development. Eligible activities include market research and planning, on-farm market infrastructure, business planning, succession planning, farm financial assessments, and human resource development, including the organization and delivery of agricultural conferences and workshops to enhance knowledge in the sector.

## Future Farms Program

This program will enable the Newfoundland and Labrador agriculture industry to attract new farmers and investment, realize economic growth opportunities, as well as meet food self-sufficiency targets. Eligible activities will include mentoring programs to match new entrants with experienced farmers; as well as financial support to the Newfoundland and Labrador Young Farmers Forum to provide services and training to young farmers interested in a career in agriculture.



## Mitigating Agricultural Risks Program

This program will enable the sector to identify and respond to risks, and to implement risk prevention and risk mitigation measures. Eligible activities will include food safety advisory services and training, implementation of beneficial management practices, biosecurity assurance systems, traceability measures, animal health and welfare measures, farm safety awareness and training, and the development of risk assessments and agriculture emergency preparedness plans.

## Environmental Sustainability and Climate Change Program

This program will promote environmentally responsible agriculture, address agriculture's impacts on natural resources, reduce greenhouse gas emissions, and mitigate and adapt to the impacts of climate change. Eligible activities include environmental farm planning; implementation of beneficial management practices such as water resource management, soil conservation, nutrient management, and waste management and environmental stewardship; and climate change mitigation and adaptation measures.
